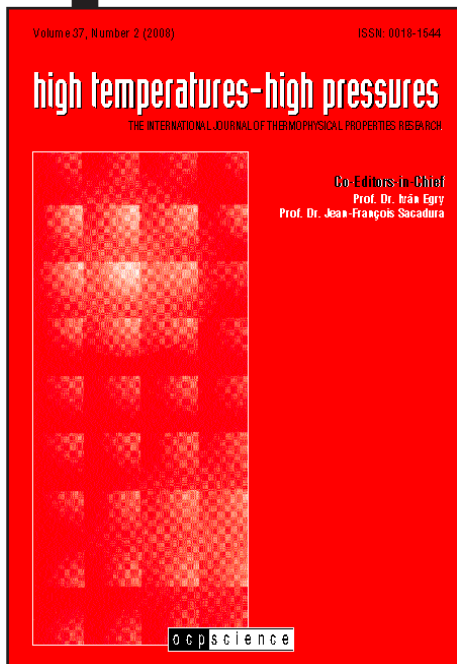

This international journal publishes original research papers related to thermophysical properties of matter, including thermal and transport properties. Papers dealing with the gaseous, liquid or solid phase are equally welcome. Special emphasis is put on matter under extreme conditions such as high temperatures and high pressures, on properties of micro- or nano-structured materials, and on non-linear properties related to high rates of energy transport. Both, theoretical and experimental work will be considered for publication. Reports on measurements of thermophysical property data as well as on the use of these data for applications form an integral part of the journal's scope. Papers on novel experimental techniques and critical compilations and analyses of existing data may also be submitted. From time to time, the editors will solicit review papers on specific topics of general interest to the thermophysics community.

Notes for Contributors High Temperatures-High Pressures

In order to ensure timely handling of manuscripts, contributors are encouraged to read these instructions carefully before preparing a manuscript for submission, and to check the manuscript for compliance with these notes before submitting it for publication.

Submission of Manuscripts

Please submit your manuscript preferably via the journal's homepage <http://services.bepress.com/hthp> or, alternatively, via e-mail to the editor at: HThP@oldcitypublishing.com. Please include complete postal addresses, e-mail addresses, and telephone and fax numbers for all authors of the article.

The preferred order of presentation is Title Page, Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgments, References, Tables, Figure Legends, and Figures.

Submission of a paper to High Temperatures-High Pressures implies that it has not been published or sub-mitted elsewhere. It will also be assumed that all authors have obtained all necessary permissions for the paper to include items such as quotations, figures, tables, results of government-sponsored research, and that authors follow strict ethical rules as defined, e.g., by the American Physical Society in http://www.aps.org/policy/statements/02_2.cfm. Upon acceptance, the publisher acquires the copyright for unlimited world-wide distribution including an electronic format.

Guidelines for the Submission of Text

All submissions should be made as Microsoft Word documents or LATEX. Style files can be downloaded from the journal's homepage. All manuscripts must be submitted in English; American or British spelling may be used. Detailed instructions for authors about layout and formatting can be found at the journal's homepage.
